Arrangements for First Holy Communion and Confirmation

Due to the government restrictions we had to take the unfortunate decision to postpone all ceremonies in the church. Happily, these restrictions have been relaxed somewhat and we have made the following arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Parent(s) and children should attend a meeting in the Church on **Wednesday 19th August at 10a.m.** At this meeting we will discuss the ceremony and have a short practice in preparation for Confirmation Day. The sacrament of confirmation will be conferred on the class of 2020 on **Saturday 22nd August at 2pm**. Each child may invite no more than eight people **including** sponsor, parents and siblings

FIRST PENANCE AND FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Parent(s) and children should attend a meeting in the Church on Monday 24th August at 10a.m. At this meeting we will discuss the arrangements for First Penance and First Holy Communion. First Penance will be celebrated on Wednesday 26th August at 10a.m. Following this, we will have a practice for First Holy Communion, as described in the note sent home by the school. First Holy Communion will take place on **Sunday 30th August at 2p.m.** Each child may invite no more than eight people including parents and siblings. The capacity of the church is extremely reduced for the time being in order to ensure we can maintain social distancing. There are national regulations in place regarding the return to public worship and these place restrictions on the movement of people within the church, the sharing of microphones, communal singing, etc. To comply with these regulations the involvement of children in the ceremonies must be controlled. While the school and the parish regret this, we are sure that you will understand the rationale.

It goes without saying that anyone coming into the church must use the hand sanitiser and follow the instructions of the stewards. The congregation must remain seated throughout and no one should leave their seats in order to take photographs. The school will arrange for a group photograph to be taken at the end of the ceremony and this will be shared securely with families. At the end of the ceremony the congregation should continue to follow the instructions of the stewards so that the church can be vacated securely. We all have a responsibility to keep ourselves and others safe.

Please be aware that these guidelines are subject to government review right up until the day of the ceremony. Thank you for your cooperation.
