THE WEDDING FEAST OF CANA GOSPEL: ST JOHN 2:1-11

Today we listen to St John's account of the Wedding Feast of Cana, where Jesus performs His first miracle. At the centre of this significant moment in the life of Jesus is the role of His Mother, Mary, who puts Her true faith and confidence in the power of Her Son. The Wedding Feast of Cana is our first glimpse of Mary's role as intercessor and advocate. With confidence, we ask Mary, our Blessed Mother, who knows our needs, to take them to Her Son:

*Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary,
that never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help, or sought thine intercession
was left unaided by thee. Inspired by this confidence, I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother;
to thee do I come, before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful.*

O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy hear and answer me. Amen.
